Courses are designated as semester or full-year courses in the course catalog. Only credit for the noted designation (semester or full-year) is awarded upon completion of the course, regardless of the amount of time a student takes to complete the course. 4. All courses must be completed with a C or better to earn credit. 5. "Build-your-own" course requires paperwork to be completed by the student and approval by the academic adviser. 6. These requirements are based on the guidelines for high schools in the state of Colorado. 7. Courses may be taken in any order for subjects other than English and Math. 8. A total of 24 credits is required
